

Teachers' Day Celebration

Every year on September 5th, Teachers' Day is observed in India to commemorate the second President of India, Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, on the anniversary of his birth. From 1962 until 1967, Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan BR, an Indian scholar, philosopher, and statesman, presided over India as its president. In the past, from 1952 to 1962, he was India's vice president. From 1949 till 1952, he served as India's ambassador to the Soviet Union. Dr. Radhakrishnan's students came to him to celebrate his birthday in 1962, the year he was elected President of India. He proposed that the day be devoted to recognizing all instructors rather than just his own birthday.
